Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Days of Remembrance are commemorated each year to remember the victims of the Holocaust, when six million people were persecuted and murdered between 1933 and 1945 by Nazi Germany and its collaborators; and,

WHEREAS, the history of the Holocaust offers an opportunity to reflect on the moral responsibilities of individuals, societies and governments to remain vigilant against hatred, persecution and tyranny; and,

WHEREAS, we should actively rededicate ourselves to the principles of individual freedom in a just society by remembering the victims, honoring the survivors, and working to promote human dignity and confront hate whenever and wherever it occurs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEPHEN TERRELL, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALLEN, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, do hereby proclaim May 1-8, 2011, as:

“HOLOCAUST DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE”
