PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, the history of the Holocaust offers an opportunity to reflect on the moral responsibilities of individuals, societies, and governments; and
- WHEREAS, Hoosiers should always remember the terrible events of the Holocaust and remain vigilant against hatred, persecution, and tyranny; and
- WHEREAS, Hoosiers should actively rededicate themselves to the principles of individual freedom in a just society; and
- WHEREAS, we can overcome intolerance and indifference through learning and remembrance; and
- WHEREAS, "The Days of Remembrance" have been set aside for the people of Indiana to remember the victims of the Holocaust as well as to reflect on the need for respect of all people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim May 1 – May 8, 2011 as

DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE

in the State of Indiana in memory of the victims of the Holocaust and in honor of the survivors, rescuers and liberators, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
